AI Prompt: Generate a Full Lesson Plan

Use this prompt in ChatGPT, Gemini, Claude, or any other AI tool:

"Create a complete [subject] lesson plan for [grade level] on the topic of [insert topic]. Make it 45 minutes long. Include: objective, standards (use Common Core if applicable), materials needed, warm-up activity, direct instruction, student activity, and a wrap-up with an exit ticket. Keep it age-appropriate and engaging."

Refinement Tips: Get Better Results from AI

AI is your assistant, not your replacement. Think of the first draft as a starting point, not the final version.

After you run the prompt, read what it gives you. Then use follow-ups like:

"Make it more interactive."

"Add a hands-on activity using common classroom materials."

"Simplify the language for 4th graders."

"Adjust timing to fit into a 30-minute block."

The more feedback you give, the better it gets.
